

PFO Minutes for November 13, 2008

The meeting opened with a prayer. The minutes were read and approved.

Teacher Representative: Mrs. Curran was present and wanted to thank PFO for the contribution for the new playground equipment. Funds also came from a donor and memorial contributions for a parishioner that recently passed away. The equipment will be behind the parish office and will hopefully take one weekend to complete installation.

Treasurer Report: Laurie Schrader provided a statement reporting that PFO has a cash balance of \$12, 200. Laurie also reported the items that have been funded by PFO since July.

Cookie Dough/Cake/Sock sale: Nora Steinmetz reported on behalf of Diane Schultz that 112 cakes were sold, 750 tubs of cookie dough and 270 packages of socks. 29 of the socks sold went to donation. More cakes were sold this year and less cookie dough.

Retail Rewards: Carol Overstreet reported that the Boxtop store is doing well. \$50 worth of coupon books for the Community Day shopping event has been sold. The next Dine to Donate is November 18, 2008 at Applebee's in Castleton.

Breakfast with Santa: Carol Overstreet and Barb Butcher have agreed to organize the event this year. Claudia Adams reported that she has 400 cookies being donated to St. Lawrence that could be used for this event instead of ordering donuts this year.

Teacher Time Off: The PFO organized teacher time off during the holiday season was discussed. A volunteer is needed to help coordinate this.
